VENDOR COVID19 - RULES AND REGULATIONS

Vendors must comply with all COVID19 rules defined here, including those put forth by the Washtenaw County Health Department* and Michigan's State Orders & Directives**. As these are subject to change by June 5th, vendors will be asked to reaffirm their compliance with the current rules and regulations at the time when checking in for the event.

Physical Distancing

Physical distancing should continue to be implemented. Physical distancing means avoiding working in close groups and maintaining distance (approximately 6 feet or 2 meters) from others when possible. Strategies include:

- Increasing physical space between employees at the worksite;
- Increasing physical space between employees and customers (e.g., table partitions, ground markings at checkout, limitations on the number of people allowed at a vendor at a time);
- Set up vendor space to minimize or eliminate customers from handling products or other items until they have finalized a purchase
- If selling products, use technology to encourage pre-sales, and reduce face-to-face sales interactions.

Screening

All organizers, attendees and vendors will be screened and must confirm the following questions:

- Do you have symptoms of fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, diarrhea or new loss of taste or smell that may not be attributable to regular symptoms related to a chronic medical condition? Yes/No
- Have you had close contact in the last 14 days with an individual diagnosed with COVID19? Yes/No
- Have you travelled internationally or outside of Michigan in the last 14 days, excluding commuting from a home location outside of Michigan? For purposes of this screening, commuting is defined as traveling between one's home and work on a regular basis. Yes/No

If anyone answers "yes" to any of the screening questions, they will not be permitted to attend and should self-isolate/self-quarantine at home for:

- If symptoms are present, a minimum of 7 days since symptoms first appear. Must also have 3 days without fevers and improvement in respiratory symptoms;
- 14 days if the person had close contact with an individual diagnosed with COVID-19;
- Or 14 days following international or domestic travel.

A record of all persons screened will be kept and provided to local health departments

Cleaning and PPE

Vendors will provide sufficient PPE to all their own employees present at their space. Face coverings are for all persons in settings where physical distancing of greater than six feet cannot be maintained.

Vendors will wipe down shared surfaces with disinfectant at the beginning, middle and end of the day. Any surface touched by a member of the public will be disinfected (pens, clipboards, etc.). Vendors should consider using disposable gloves appropriately as additional protection, but remember that gloves do not replace the need to wash hands and practice good hand hygiene. Vendors are responsible for their own sanitization supplies, clean-up, and disposal. All persons are encouraged to wash hands thoroughly or utilize hand sanitizer before and after using any equipment and after coughing, sneezing, or blowing their nose. Organizers will provide a sanitization station indicated on the event map.

Reporting

Violations of the COVID19 rules and regulations should be reported to the event manager.
