**Tree Information & Planting**


Care must be taken when selecting fall planting sites and soils for the best winter survival. Avoid planting in low areas that may collect water and freeze, damaging trees. Limit planting in heavier clay soils because they have a greater tendency to freeze and thaw, causing trees to be heaved out of the ground.

Use mulch to help moderate soil temperatures and reduce heaving.
