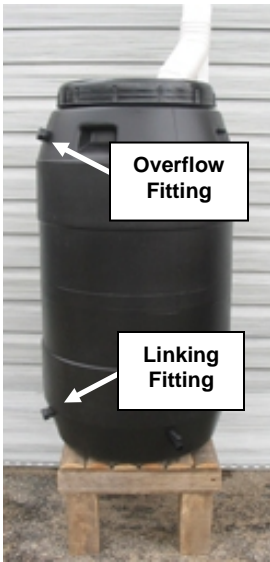


Linking Hose

Thank you for purchasing a Linking Hose from UpCycle Products and the Washtenaw County Conservation District. Your purchase helps support the work of the District in Washtenaw County.

A Linking Hose is used for attaching multiple barrels together. All Upcycle rain barrels are supplied with a linking fitting toward the bottom end of the barrel directly below the overflow fitting. This allows you to modify only one downspout from the roof in any given location around the home or building and have increased storage capacity.



Simply remove the cap from the two linking fittings, thread the linking hose to the two linking fittings and the barrels are now joined. No tools required.

The barrel taking the water from the roof then shares with the rest of the barrels that are linked together through the linking hose. All barrels will fill equally and then empty equally. Some increase in pressure will be realized. However, the main advantage is increased capacity.

During summer months when barrels start getting low, a 15-minute rain or thunderstorm will fill all your barrels back to capacity and will allow you to go for up to several weeks without rain while watering gardens and hanging plants.
